How To Be Anointed By God

I want us to learn and I thank God that by His grace we are a generation that loves the Lord. It takes time to know God. It takes time to access genuine power. something happens to this body when it is exposed to the presence of God. The moment the glory of God begins to interact with this body, the body becomes uncomfortable, and all of a sudden you'll find out you can see people after service, waiting outside at a snacks shop for two hours, but once they see 10 minutes in the glory, as that glory is coming, that resistance, your flesh, something in you wants to move out, you want to eat, you want to ease yourself, that's the time to stay because something is happening to you in the spirit. You notice how uncomfortable you get in the glory, the Bible says "the flesh is weak" so don't mind it, don't let it cheat you. As the glory of God descend upon you regardless of what you feel, the devil begins to bring distractions, I want to make a call I forgot, I want to do this, the flesh is reacting to the glory and you see many of us because we are weak, there is no capacity in the spirit to sustain the staying power to say remain, that's where the miracle lives. It is in staying.

When Jesus resurrected, all the other disciples came but they could not be patient enough to see Him so they looked at the tomb and they went. But a woman came when she looked, she re-

mains there and while she stayed and stayed, two angels appeared and said woman what is happening, she said am looking for Jesus, they said Jesus has resurrected. That means there was a piece of information that the patience of the apostles would have given them. When you stay in His presence, something happens to you, it will look like you're not hearing God like you're not even sure, you're thinking about a plate of food, just remain, that's where Satan cheats us.

Listen, you think that because your mind is going around you're not spiritual, your flesh is fighting a war that it will lose for sure. So your secret is not to fight, just remain there, a time will come, your flesh will give up. And all of a sudden, you will step into a dimension, you will now hear a word, you will hear a Rhema. You've been listening all the while but your flesh is fighting. That is why many people do not receive. When you come to church, that is not the time (except you're working in the media) to chat on your phone and browse and do all these and you're trying to catch up with someone, and you notice how the devil cheats us. Someone just sent you a message quickly and you say ah, let me take this opportunity, and all of a sudden your spirit is distracted. not every word from God blesses you, it is the word that is sent. There are all kinds of words but it is the word that is sent.

That the word is available does not mean it will change you. Your hunger is what makes it becomes a sent word. That the word of breakthrough is here, it doesn't mean you will have a breakthrough. You see, this is where believers cheat themselves. And am glad that this is a conference that God is helping us. Today is a retreat that is what we're doing tonight. Just a retreat to flush away all the things that is garbage that the devil can use to bring us down. "A Sent Word" the word is not just sent until there is hunger. Something must rise from the earth like incense and your hunger now calls the presence of God and the word is sent.

God gave you a will, He can't assume you need His help. So He waits for your hunger. Your hunger is your call in the spirit. That you're saying Lord I need you, this is not something I have an op-

tion for I need you. The Sent Word! It is not the man of God, it is not the word, but if your connection is through genuine desire, then it becomes a sent word. There were many widows in *Zarephath*, how could a loving God not send Elijah to say “all widows come” there was something that woman was doing that made God say to Elijah, Stand up, go to her...

Look at the story of that Blind man, He said “thou son of David” he never said, Jesus. I know that you’re not just Jesus a man but there is more to you. Was David his father? Solomon was the son of David. He said I have a revelation, I’ve been noticing your passing here and I will not miss this opportunity and then Jesus stops and asks a very sarcastic question. “What should I do for you?” You can’t assume a blind man wants to see. You see because the lame man in the book of Acts wanted money not to walk. So you can’t assume that because you’re in trouble God should know. Unto Him that answers prayer, not creates it, He creates hunger. Your hunger makes you to cry out in desperation and He comes. Sent Word!

Prayer - (“Lord please send my word” not send our word, send my word...)

(*Prayer:* Send my word! That word that can take me to a new dimension, that word that will turn my family around, that word that will give me an encounter. That word that will set me upon my feet.)

In every generation, there are always a group of people, it could be few individuals, could be a nation that avails themselves to be used by God in that generation to establish His purposes and His plans. Now you must understand that the word eternity simply means the summation of infinite dispensations. it doesn’t just mean a straight line of living, it means dispensation connecting dispensation. And in every dispensation, God is not doing the same thing. There is an emphasis of God that captions a dispensation. You are only relevant to God and by implication to that generation not just to the degree to which you were alive but to the degree to which you understand the emphasis of the spirit for

that dispensation and aligning with it. The anointing of the spirit is God's capacity to produce results. But the anointing is not necessarily generic in operation. There is the anointing allocated for a generation, there is the anointing for your spiritual growth but the anointing, a grace dimension reserved for a generation. And the anointing of the spirit follows the words, His emphasis for a generation. That means that if in this generation if God is calling people to love Him more, the anointing to be present within that encounter is the anointing that causes men to desire God more. So whoever that will carry that anointing is the person...

You can be a wonderful person, you can have the anointing given to you based on your spiritual life, but you cannot carry the anointing for the agenda of God in a season until you know what He's saying. So the anointing doesn't just come to you just because you desire it, the anointing follows where the Spirit of God is going which is where the word of God is going. If God is talking breakthrough, the anointing that is there is the anointing for breakthrough and whoever that will carry the anointing is the person who understands that breakthrough is what God is doing now, may not be what He did yesterday, may not be what He would do tomorrow. This is the reason why you find out that you can find many people for a period of ten years be very current and alive in what God is doing, and then all of a sudden maybe 11, 12 years, they're still there, maybe in ministry, they are there but they are not there. They are there but you know that they are just around, they are no longer on point. Something happened, a transition of God's emphasis shifted but they did not sustain the hearing ear and the seeing eye to move with Him. That God started using you yesterday does not guarantee He will use you tomorrow. You can listen to my messages of when I started working with God but that does not reveal you're being blessed by my worth and my work with God of yesterday but that doesn't guarantee that at the time you were being blessed by that message am still in line with God.

Remember that Solomon was not always in a depressed state. Once upon a time that Solomon experienced the manifested presence of God twice. He saw the shekinah of God, but by the time we got to Ecclesiastes, Solomon was a frustrated man who was almost as though he didn't know anything about God again. It is costly to believe that just because you were part of what God was doing yesterday... this is not salvation, this is not redemption, you're still in Christ. But we're are talking of the impact of the move of God within a season. Once upon a time, the coordinator of Gods people was Eli, Eli was a priest of God, he was not fake. The bible records that at a time in his life his eyes started becoming dim. And remember that the bible says eyes is the light of the body, it says if your eye be single then your whole body is full of light and now his eyes started becoming dim, what happened? The voice of God came to the same temple where Eli was but Eli didn't hear, so the voice left him and went to a small boy - Samuel, Eli was there, why would God bypass Eli?

How about Saul? Saul was a man who was anointed by Samuel. Samuel said it that is it not God has chosen. This was God who chose, will God make mistake? Is He not Alpha and Omega? Can't he see the end of a man? Why choose a man that will not last? Because your longevity in God's program is not determined by Him, it is determined by your hunger, your passion, and your continually following Him. Saul was anointed king of Israel. The bible records that once upon a time, Samuel has delayed in coming to offer the sacrifice and the bible says the people began to mount pressure upon Saul and then Saul said what is there? Am I not chosen by God? He now offers the sacrifices, one may think that while he was offering the sacrifices God won't accept it, God kept quiet. God is interesting if you know God.

There are some things about God that are wonderful and there are some things that are really scary. A man is disobeying God and He keeps quiet. Where is His mercy that is new every morning? Then He keeps quiet and allows Saul to just be messing up his destiny and then Samuel shows up. I want to teach you something

powerful. Samuel shows up and says Saul what have you done? And he says you were not there, time is going and the people are mounting pressure and Samuel says no, you have done foolishly. He says you would have waited patiently for me to come and offer the sacrifice and then God would have established your kingdom forever. So it would have been "thou son of Saul" have mercy on me. But then you have done this and this day, God has taken the kingdom away from you. And Saul thought it was a joke. God took His kingdom but he still went to the palace that day whereas the kingdom has left. He sat down on the throne but the chair didn't refuse to take him. In the realm of the spirit, the light that makes man relevant within a season has left him. Brothers and sisters hear me, it is my desire that we all are not just born again, not just filled with the Holy Spirit, but to be at the epicenter of what God is doing in Nigeria, in Africa, and in the world.

I say this with all humility, many of you have been blessed by my life, you've been blessed by our ministry but let me tell you this, thank God for the revelations, thank God for the anointing, and thank God for all of these things. But the greatest secret I would say, maybe secondary to my love for God is that I will never be found where God is not. If God is moving this way and decides to reverse, I'm not proud to join Him, you see that? The problem is that the way we move. We move in such a way that we carry our ego along. So when God moves back you say, they're not seeing God but they are seeing me. If I move back, they may say maybe am not hearing God well. Then you continue moving and if His presence doesn't go with you, that is already a sign that you are out. This happens in business, you find out that people are excelling, and they started coming down, is not just demons, many times it is the violation of our spiritual order. We do not know how God is doing things. A business can be thriving and a man thinks he is thriving just because he is tithing and giving, no! There was something in the heart of God and he came and donated himself and business to the agenda and God says because you were part of my program, certain privileges will happen to

you. And then it gets to a point where God says I've decided to shift this way and he says Lord I've come too far, my reputation around this thing is too much at stake and God says you have your will.

That is what happened to Lucifer. Lucifer the Son of the Morning was to the then dispensation what Jesus was to our dispensation. A revelation of the love of the father. And it got to a point where Lucifer felt that he could no longer continue with his allegiance and God respected his will. He respected his will and out he went.

My greatest fear is not losing ministry, is not losing relevance, is that God is here and I find myself here and inspire a generation to move away from Him to follow me. I don't know how I will stand before God and what explanation am going to give Him. That God is here and you tell people God is with me and they say we believe you. Do you know that influence is a burden, it is true! If you fear God, you will be careful to receive influence because there is a weightier judgment upon you. When you inspire people to veer off the program of God, many people in the church in Nigeria as a corporate body, most of the errors here and there were not initiated by the people. It was usually men and women of influence who for some reason edged out of the program of God and continued moving and then multitude will follow.

**The emphasis of the spirit. Why are we gathered here in this conference? It is because we believe that God is doing something in our generation and we believe that we are part of his program. Much more than receiving miracles. That we are part of something that God is doing and we're not ashamed to come together, not just as members but as a generation. To say Lord reveal your blueprint, equip us, prepare us. Once upon a time, we were young people, once upon a time many of us were students. But right now many of us are family people. Right now responsibility, the influence... The implication of this is that the situations that you complain about, while you were complaining you were moving forward to it and now the light is on you. In the next 10, 15 years you'll be surprised to see your baby now grown and say daddy,

I learned you were complaining about this situation, now you have become a father, and now I have even become a teenager and nothing changed. It's easy to insult our loved ones, it's easy to insult our parents, you didn't do this, daddy why were you not part of what God was doing? You claimed you were classmate with this man of God, where were you when God was speaking to him? And now while you were complaining you were growing older and the devil is using bitterness to distract you while you keep growing. And now you have gotten to a point where you should begin to make a mark for the kingdom, but we're still there wallowing in anger and bitterness, but not after this conference because God is visiting us to prepare our heart. Brothers and sisters, being relevant in God's program, you've always heard me say, requires an encounter. Desire is important but it will take more than a desire to represent God in a generation.

I love the body of Christ, I don't mean to insult any theology or whatever but let me tell you this: one of the greatest areas in the body of Christ where there is a lot of confusion is the area of faith. How faith works and why it doesn't work. That I can believe God for something and yet never see the result. I will tell you why. Because you see, one of the most fundamental keys to throw bible faith is an encounter. Not just an awareness of the word. Everybody who manifested through bible faith manifested faith from an encounter. Now watch this, am putting my hand in his suit pocket, can you feel my hand? You may not see it; this is a reality to you. It is an encounter. This is real, his eyes don't need to confirm it, this is a reality. If you come to tell him that your hands are not in the suit pocket, will he believe you? What has happened to him is more than your proposition? The reason why many of our believers in this country and many of us young people we don't know what we believe, today you believe healing is real, tomorrow you say you're not exactly sure. Today you see demons cast out you say I believe it, next tomorrow you say no, I don't need anything. The reason is that our confidence is not rooted in genuine encounters. If we do not have a genuine encounter, we'll

have nothing to tell our children. Because the darkness will fade away your convictions to the point that when people stand and ask that what do you believe, you say it depends on the year. From 1981 to 1987 I believe this and then something happened in 1988, etc. This is why you see many people, with due respect to our parents and loved ones. At age 50 to 60, they see you and you say i am going on evangelism and they say God helps you. You say look at me, i am an evangelism secretary. Evangelism secretary with desire but no encounter. So the person served God while on campus but no encounter, and then graduated and believed for a job, no job, no open doors and he or she just say this God is a scam. That was once an evangelism secretary. The reason why many of our teenagers and our young people today especially our millenia hate God sometimes very vocally is that we have not been able to answer their questions.

Social media is answering their questions. When the child says daddy, I don't understand why we believe the scriptures, you say if you talk to me again I will slap you and the child goes to ask Google. "Why do people refuse to get encounter?" and one unbelieving YouTube video will come out and the man will say, don't mind all those touts called Christians, and your child says that's right. That man is resonating with my belief. When asked if they can go to church, he says for what? When I have a new pastor, someone is educating me and he's giving me something that looks truer and more real than what is given in the church. We need genuine encounters with God to establish the faith and the conviction that will last to be able to tell a generation that they are wrong. A generation, not a membership, not a city that you can stand and say oh generation that you're moving left does not mean that is the way. I've met God, I know God and I will stand with Him forever. This is the kind of generation that God is looking for. As pastors, as leaders, as workers, many of us find out that we find ourselves in double standards. The popular is the one you quietly identify with for a moment.

Imagine a scenario, If I look at a girl and say you're a man. Do you

think she will go home and check herself to confirm? Will she ask her mother? No! This cannot be because there is an encounter. Something about her womanhood has been so real that if someone calls her a man, she will feel sorry for that person and hopes that the person finds a doctor. No matter how bold he is, this is called an encounter. An encounter is an experience that furnishes the reality of a person or a thing to you.

The lady is not trying to believe that she is a man. Our problem with faith is that we try to believe. But I know who I believe not I am believing. I started it one day and I came to the end of it and it is settled and I am persuaded. So you believe God for a job as we say oh Lord I believe you for a job and after two years, someone calls you and says there is a job coming but you're going to pay N250,000 as a bribe. When you ask why they say don't ask me that question, are you not a Nigerian? Then you quietly smuggled the money and then in the church, you come out and sing to God "*You've been faithful Lord, from the ages past...*" and while you're singing, your son who saw you or your younger brother who drinks and saw you making the transfer hears you telling lies on the stage about how you got the job. And he's shocked that you lied in the church. Do you know at a point, you yourself would have accumulated a lot of falsehood around your Christian experience that you will not know what to believe again. But I know who I believe.

We shall see three scriptural passages;

Psalms 24:6 *This is the generation of them that seek him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. Selah.*

This is where my story begins: "Oh God of Jacob" not oh God of Israel. That means there is a relationship between Jacob and the seeking that we should study. You should see how the bible works. It leaves you with an exposition so that from there you start trailing yourself. The bible says that there is a generation that seeks God and there was a man that portrays that dimension of hunger to the point that God named Himself after that man's pursuit and the name of that man is Jacob.

Genesis 28:10-22 (Read through to 22)

[10]And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran.

[11]And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep.

[12]And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it.

[13]And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

[14]And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

[15]And, behold, I am with thee, and will keep thee in all places whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done that which I have spoken to thee of.

The bible says he called the name of the place Bethel which literally means a place of bread, the place of encounter. But the name of the place was called Los at the first. So we see that Jacob had an encounter. His father Abraham had raised an altar for God within that area. It's amazing how this thing works. That your work with God can give you a name that God Himself will reference you. That means God can say to our children. I am the God of Joshua Selman, the Faithful God. That means when you want to study God's faithfulness, study Joshua Selman. There is something that the God of Abraham reveals to the church. There is something the God of Isaac reveals to the church. That is why you hear people say the God of this and that. Once it is understood, it is a powerful revelation. Because that means that there is a way you have worked with God and you know the pathway and God have carved His name out of your encounter and reference a generation to follow that path to experience that dimension of faith. So when you say God of Benny Hinn, what you're saying is that

God walked with Benny Hinn in a certain way that brought him to the place of the anointing. And anyone who wants to manifest the dimension of the anointing, God recommends a man on earth as the case study. The bible says looking on to Jesus. When you want to finish strong in faith, the reference is Jesus. Bible says He is the author and finisher of our faith.

But there are other men who are all part of Jesus that God can reference that you look up to. When the bible talks about prayer, effective prayer, it is the God of Elijah. So we go to the book of James and the bible says the fervent and effectual prayer of a righteous man, but because you may not understand I walked with a man that exemplifies that dimension. Then He says Elijah was a man of like passion. So He's teaching about prayer and He uses a man called Elijah. When God teaches about faith, He uses Peter. He says Peter, Satan desires to sift you as wheat but I have prayed for you that your faith fails not and when you are converted, don't forget about your brethren, strengthen them, write epistles that will strengthen your brethren. When the bible talks about men who represented the counsel of God in a way and manner that the earth was no longer relevant for them, the bible talks of Enoch –the 7th man from creation. It says and Enoch walked with God. So when you want to learn how to walk with God so closely, there is a man he recommends. Jesus didn't just walk Himself, He found men who score that mark well and became their God.

When we look at church growth in the world we say the God of Youngi Chun, why? It doesn't mean I don't know anything about church growth but a man asked God questions and refused to leave. He sat down there and said God if I perish, I perish. Show me the mystery of church growth and then when he was converted, he strengthened the brethren. And today now many people have become epistles. Leading epistles from his sacrifice. Listen, there is a name that your life should give God for this generation. If all our children knows about God is that He is the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob we have failed. Abraham never wrote exams and

failed. So you failed an exam, started another course and you have graduated and your experience is giving God a name that when a student goes to 100 level God will say I am the God of Kemi and you say who is Kemi and he says go and study in this university, find out the lady that studied for twelve years and yet graduated with first class. Your pain is not useless in the school of encounter; it is part of the build-up for the testimony.

Remember that God says the premise for that encounter was that the sun went down. It was a season; many people cannot encounter God because the level of convenience in your house will never bring you to a point where you will need Him. The sun has to set so that he could no longer see light, he gave up in himself and says I need to rest and then he slept. There are many people who are too innocent to worship God. They are standing in broad daylight. so when they say God is faithful, worship God, they complain that the time of worship is too long. Yet another person is worshipping and don't wish to stop. Because there is a story behind that person that worships. There is a name your pain needs to give God. When you stand, you should be able to say I am a living sacrifice. If you're trusting God for a ministry here, the requirement for ministry is that you must have a track record with God enough for your experience to give Him a name that is worth a generation listening to you. The generation of now will not listen to you because you have Rhema. There is nothing you will preach today that people cannot search with a click online. There are a lot of churches streaming online. It is good to know the God of other people so that you will now know Him as your God. It is the final bus stop.

Song:

*How can I bow down before you and the bow down before a man
no way...!*

So the bible says "This is the generation that will seek your face oh God" and the portrait that was given to that generation as a case study is Jacob! So we're studying Jacob. Jacob comes to a place and God tells him, Abraham had business with me and I am

his God. God called himself the God of Abraham. And he says Isaac followed the God of Abraham to the point that I became the God of Isaac. There was something that Isaac saw with God that Abraham did not see. Jacob, it's your turn. Follow Abraham, follow Isaac until I become your God. And he agreed. For Joseph, he was too innocent to know that God was there. And the next stop was the house of Laban. Jacob went to the house of Laban and he went through hell. Laban oppressed him. Laban did not give Jacob the woman he requested to marry but instead gives him another of his daughter. Jacob served another 7 years and he is yet defrauded. Laban goes to consult with diviners asking why he is still blessed. He is told that God is with Jacob adding that the fact that Jacob didn't know does not mean God is not with him. Remember God was not there as the God of Jacob, there was something about Abraham "In thee shall all the families be blessed" that is not the God of Jacob but the God of Abraham. Jacob knew that so it was working for him. That anywhere he went to, he will be blessed because he was carrying a revelation. But there is time for him to create his own track record. One day, he decided to leave Laban. Until that time, we did not know how Christians respond when they are oppressed. So a man's life is about to give us a template.

Laban defrauded Jacob. Your boss is not the first to treat you bad, find out. At the end of it when Jacob left Laban, the bible records that he began to hear that Esau was coming. He became uncomfortable remembering that he has defrauded his brother. Though Esau has deviated from God but he was still being blessed by the God of Abraham.

This is the reason why Nigeria cannot scatter. There are quiet strange men that did something with God in this nation. They agreed with God and left. Although they are gone, but the covenant stands.

Genesis 32: 22-

By this time Jacob was not innocent of the wickedness of men. He had gone through so much. The first night time in his life he was so innocent. But this one, he had been battered, he has two wives

with maids. His life was about to be threatened, his brother Esau could slay him. So before meeting Esau, Jacob decided to separate his possessions into two. This is so that when Esau captures him, he can have something left for himself. At this time, he was still a cheat.

Don't waste your night time. When night season comes in your life, though God may not cause it but once God sees night, He is attracted. Because He knows that night is an atmosphere that can allow you to know Him. There is a name that God wants to give you through your pain. Most of you were brought here by your night. Sometimes, don't be too quick to wipe people's tears. Allow the tears to drive them to God's presence. I am not saying you should not be compassionate but sometimes we interrupt what God is doing in people's lives too much. Most of our night times leaves us lonely which is very good for encounters. Sometimes many of us are too among people for God to visit us. There is a corporate visitation of God. But God has to wait.

In the scriptures read above, my favorite line is "And Jacob was left alone". That is an atmosphere for encounters. So when left alone, your reputation is gone, everything gone and you're being mocked because you're left alone. So you call God and He's silent yet in His silence, He's calling on you to come.

ᵎOlorun t"o da awon oke igbani,

Eyin ni mo fi ope mi fun...ᵎ

"And Jacob was left alone" God never came while Jacob was busy. Don't waste your pain, there is something about God that you can know through your pain. And in the night, Jacob wrestled with God and refused to allow God to go until he was blessed.

The 28th verse says and God asked what his name was, he told God Jacob and God says, "Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel" Jacob then renames the place, Pennell, meaning the Face of God.

Until then, anyone that sees God dies, but something about Jacob's encounter introduced that one can see God and live. God

says there is a generation that will seek me and still live, they will know me, they will seek my face. Study Jacob. Remember that this encounter was likened to a prince who fights. A spirit of a warrior. Encounter will give you faith and confidence.

I have found some things about God and I am sure today that when you find His truth, a generation must stand still to listen to you. No matter how proud they are, they will listen. Except you don't find it. I see what God is doing through our ministry and see what God is doing in and through my life, and I look and said to myself that that scripture is true. "They looked unto Him and their faces were lightened" You have been looking unto men, you have been looking unto a lot of things.

Let me share with you just one of those encounters. Confidence today is based on the word of God but much more than that because I have seen Him. When I read the bible, it's not just by faith, I am reading an experience that is real. I got to a point where my hunger for God would almost kill me if I didn't find Him. As many of you know my grandfather was a man of God. Yet I didn't inherit anything. All I inherited was that I saw a lot of white missionaries with him till he died. That is not enough to help me. I got to a point where I was tired of church, I asked people questions and they could not answer. Something in my spirit keeps telling me to stay until I find the answer.

One night, I was lying down flat. And then all of a sudden, a stranger, I don't know whether he walked into the room or whether he appeared, I don't even know. All I know is that standing before me was Jesus Christ, the son of the Living God. I was amazed that the One that parted the Red Sea was standing before Joshua Salman. I have seen miracles here and there. I have seen the hands of God, God was helping me, but this was an encounter. Jesus stood before me, never asked me if I was a man of God, never asked me if I want fame, never asked me if I needed money, never asked me if I wanted a car, never asked me if I wanted to be famous in life and

ministry. Many of us are getting it all wrong because these are the questions you will like to ask Him: how will I be famous now?

And He looked at me, remember I told you that I can't describe how he looks like. Jesus looked at me, brilliance at its peak! He didn't condemn me but I knew I was filthy. This is not self-condemnation, but I knew I was standing before Holiness personified. Don't forget this is Jesus. This is the King of the Ages, the One that men of God represent. I have realized that not many people know Jesus. He stood and never spoke with me, yet He spoke volumes. And out He stretched His hand, with brilliant light. Then the light entered me. That light was a name, a message, and an identity. He was giving me an identity that a generation will follow after. I didn't realize that was what was happening. That light entered me and I felt peace, love, you will not trade that presence for anything. Imagine being in a place where there is no awareness of pain, a place where you know that when you ask anything and He says "Done!" then truly it is done. After that encounter, He left mysteriously. Brothers and sisters, from that night, something entered me that I knew was bigger than me. I knew it was for a generation. This is the generation that seeks thy face. I started understanding some things in the bible that I haven't studied. I write and read my own revelation like prophecy because I didn't know what it was.

From that singular encounter, I was open to a realm of strange encounters. By the spirit, I've had encounters with many of those we call God's generals. I have seen them. I have seen Apostle Paul. Remember when Jesus appeared two people showed up, Moses and Elijah. What were they doing? These are two men who left the earth and their bodies were not found. Because someone's body too was going to leave and not be found. These two men appeared

and spoke with Jesus. The mystery of keeping the law and the prophetic is what translates men. If we want to rise in this kingdom, we must encounter the laws of the kingdom and the ministry of the prophetic. And no matter what dies, must come up. It was not ordinary Moses and Elijah, they represented something. So every time death happens to you, you need two things (i) an understanding of the principles of the kingdom and (ii) and the encounter with a prophetic dimension. When that happens, you must come out of the grave. This is a mystery.

Many people want to come out of the grave of their life but they have not kept the principles of the kingdom. There is Moses or principles of the kingdom as we call it in the New Testament, but Elijah is not there. They are taken for prey and no man sayeth restore.

I started having several encounters. One time, I had an encounter and I saw a very strange being, an angel. Though I have seen a lot of angels but this particular one is strange. And the Lord told me that this angel is called the angel of the Lord's presence. That angel, for strange reasons, is responsible for initiating encounters. It is a ministry. Like Gabriel came to Daniel and says "I am come to give you understanding". Remember that God signifies call and his revelations by His angels.

Revelation 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:

When God gives you a mandate and anointing, there are certain angels that follow that anointing. Not you, but they follow whoever carries that anointing. And under the leadership of the spirit, they are the ones who produce the possibilities. So you carry one unclear message, which you may not fully understand and when you play it, you begin to attract angels and the spirit that comes with the anointing behind that message. And you find out that you can't stop again. It may not be a message that is entirely new, but you will see that something strange will be happening to you. That is the mystery behind all these messages. It is not just elo-

quence.

Brothers and sisters, you have heard people with deep revelations but there are mysteries surrounding every result you see. Why are we gathered here by the spirit? Because God wants to bring us into this reality. There is a depth of encounter that when you have, all the things that men run after will follow you. Men don't just follow a man no.

In every generation, there are always a group of people, it could be few individuals, could be a nation that avails themselves to be used by God in that generation to establish His purposes and His plans. Now you must understand that the word eternity simply means the summation of infinite dispensations. It doesn't just mean a straight line of living, it means dispensation connecting dispensation. And in every dispensation, God is not doing the same thing. There is an emphasis of God that captions a dispensation. You are only relevant to God and by implication to that generation not just to the degree to which you were alive but to the degree to which you understand the emphasis of the spirit for that dispensation and aligning with it. The anointing of the spirit is God's capacity to produce results. But the anointing is not necessarily generic in operation. There is the anointing allocated for a generation, there is the anointing for your spiritual growth but the anointing, a grace dimension reserved for a generation. And the anointing of the spirit follows the words, His emphasis for a generation. That means that if in this generation if God is calling people to love Him more, the anointing to be present within that encounter is the anointing that causes men to desire God more. So whoever that will carry that anointing is the person...
